EVENT LOCATION

General Daniel “Chappie” James Arena

To locate the arena:

Enter the campus through the Lincoln Gates and briefly travel on Washington Blvd. Turn left onto University Blvd. The turn will be just before you reach the statue of Booker T. Washington. You will pass Kresge Center on the left before coming to Chappie James Arena on your left and Foster Hall on your right. There is a large parking lot just beyond Chappie James Arena.

Attendance

This is our seventh annual Law School Fair. Best estimates are between 100 and 150 attendees. Many events take place in Chappie James Arena throughout the year. The area will be well visited by students. There are very few courses taught during the hours of the fair. The event will be advertised through broadcast and print news media, and social media to members of the general public and students attending the surrounding colleges and universities as well as with other HBCUs.

This event is being heavily advertised to include news articles, e-blasts, extensive use of social media, banners, yard signs with balloons, many large posters, and hundreds of small posters on campus.

Dinner Information

Dinner will be served at 4:00 PM in the museum on the 2nd floor in Chappie James Arena and with easy access to the display space. Attendants will be able to direct you to the dinner. Bottled water will be provided during the fair.

DRIVING INFORMATION

From Birmingham, AL, take Interstate 65 South to Montgomery, then transfer to Interstate 85 North. From Mobile, AL, take Interstate 65 North to Montgomery, then transfer to Interstate 85 North. From Montgomery, AL, take Interstate 85 North to the Tuskegee/Franklin exit (Exit #32). Turn RIGHT off the exit onto Pleasant Springs Drive (Co. Rd. 50/30). Go approximately 2 miles, then turn LEFT onto Franklin Road (Co. Rd. 30). Go approximately 3 miles to the end of Franklin Rd. Take a LEFT at the traffic light onto "Old" Montgomery Rd. You will see the entrance to Tuskegee University on your left. These are the Lincoln Gates. Go straight on Booker T. Washington Drive until you reach University Drive. Turn left just before reaching the statue of Booker T. Washington. Drive past Chappie James arena to reach parking. There will be directional signage to assist you in your drive.

From Atlanta or Columbus, GA, or Auburn, take Interstate 85 South to the Tuskegee/Notasulga exit (Exit #38). Turn LEFT off the exit onto Tuskegee Airmen Blvd. (Hwy. 81). Stay on this highway (approximately 2 miles) through several 90-degree turns and you will end up on North Main Street. You will see Burger King on your left. Turn RIGHT at the first traffic light onto "Old" Montgomery Rd. Drive on the "Old" Montgomery Road until you reach the Lincoln gates. Take a right through the gates. Go straight on Booker T. Washington Drive until you reach University Drive. Turn left just before reaching the statue of Booker T. Washington. Drive past Chappie James arena to reach parking. There will be directional signage to assist you in your drive.

PARKING

There is ample convenient parking adjacent to Chappie James Arena.
