



## 2021–2022 Canadian Fee Waiver Instructions

Canadian citizens, permanent residents of Canada, and Protected Persons/Convention Refugees in Canada who need a fee waiver for LSAC services may apply through the LSAC Canadian Fee Waiver process. To request a fee waiver, you must complete the following application, which determines your financial status.

Please remember to fill out the application completely and accurately. Be sure to sign and date the application. Any misrepresentation of information on the application is subject to LSAC misconduct and irregularities proceedings. You should also retain a copy of the application for your records.

Please submit your completed application by email to [CanadianFeeWaiver@LSAC.org](mailto:CanadianFeeWaiver@LSAC.org) **four to six weeks prior** to the [registration deadline](#) for the LSAT administration you wish to take. Prior to submitting your fee waiver application, please create an online account at [LSAC.org](https://lsac.org).

Please send all tax documentation supporting your fee waiver application (Notice of Assessment for you, and for your spouse or parents, if applicable) with your application by email to [CanadianFeeWaiver@LSAC.org](mailto:CanadianFeeWaiver@LSAC.org). **Your application cannot be processed if this documentation is not received.**

In the event that you are applying to U.S. law schools and are seeking a fee waiver for the LSAC Credential Assembly Service<sup>SM</sup> (CAS<sup>SM</sup>), if you are eligible, this fee waiver application will cover one registration for CAS, including three or six law school reports (depending on your tier level), the Letter of Recommendation Service, and access to electronic applications for all ABA-approved law schools.

After your application is processed, you will receive an email indicating whether your application was approved or denied. If your fee waiver application is approved, you may begin registering for services using your fee waiver. A credit card will be required for any fees not covered by the fee waiver. All credit card payments will be charged in U.S. dollars. If your fee waiver application is denied, you may appeal the decision. Appeal instructions will be included in your email notification. Please note that appeal decisions are final.
